In 2015 we released our first whiskey and we have been steadily distilling, maturing and releasing whiskeys over the past nine years receiving numerous awards with a highpoint being our 10-year-old Single Malt released in 2023.

But we are still only at the start of our journey. We hope that you can join us on our journey as we seek to grow into a globally renowned true, hand-crafted Irish whiskey.

WHY DINGLE DISTILLERY?

- We are a small, independently owned, artisan Distillery
- All of our whiskey is distilled at Dingle Distillery
- Everything we do is done by hand – we believe in a traditional approach
- We produce only 4 casks per day – we believe in quality over quantity
- Our water comes from a sustainable well 240 feet directly below our distillery
- Our wooden wash backs further enhance the final flavour
- We directly source our casks to ensure the highest quality flavours and finish
- Experienced team to guide you along the way

DINGLE WHISKEY

Dingle Whiskey is distilled, matured, and bottled at Dingle Distillery. Our spirit is triple distilled, and every aspect of our process is manual from the mashing to the addition of yeast and the cutting of the heads and tails of our spirit. Our casks are then hand-filled and after, what we believe to be, the perfect amount of time, our casks are emptied and the whiskey is manually bottled, ensuring that every aspect of the process is controlled to the highest level of quality.

We distil a maximum of four casks per day, which allows us to be hands-on with every cask of whiskey we produce. Our Distillers are involved in every aspect of the distillation process before our warehouse team take over and ensure that your cask matures in the way it has been designed to.

Dingle Whiskey is a product of its environment. From the localised well water, which comes from our sustainable well 240 feet directly below our distillery, to the immensely manual mashing, alongside the wooden fermentation vessels that feed into the three bespoke copper pot stills, the production is purely Dingle.

The micro-climate then creates a maturation like no other. We do not manipulate the course of our whiskey, only nature can do that.



Our team are on hand to work with each Descendant through cask selection process. Every cask type will provide a unique flavour profile and can be tailored to the individual Descendant's preferred style of whiskey.

As the cask matures, you will have the opportunity to sample the cask and follow its progress. You will see how the spirit character and flavour evolves over time with the increasing influence of the wood from your chosen cask type.

In eight year's time, you will then be able to choose whether to bottle the cask or to continue maturing. We will guide you along the path, offer advice on all options to allow you to choose the best one for you.

Of course, we will celebrate this eight year milestone at a party with all 2024 Descendant Cask Owners. This is a great opportunity both to network and to potentially speak with others about what their plans are for their whiskey.

You will have the option to choose your cask type.
Each cask brings its own unique characteristics to the spirit.

OVERVIEW

The Descendants Cask Programme gives individuals, groups, and businesses the opportunity to become a cask owner of the 2024 Cask Edition.

A Descendant will be a part of Dingle Distillery forever. The Distillery's fabric was built by the Founding Fathers, a group of 500 who purchased casks while the Distillery was in its infancy. From that initial group who laid the foundations to the Descendants who will pave the future for this small, artisan, independent Distillery.

Descendants are one of few people who will have the opportunity in a given year to own a single cask of Dingle whiskey. Each cask is unique to that person or group and will provide them with a piece of history of one of Ireland's most renowned distilleries. Descending from the Founding Fathers of Dingle Distillery, the Descendants 2024 are a group of like-minded, passionate people who will go on this journey together.

Each cask will be filled with spirit that has been distilled exclusively at Dingle Distillery. As with all of our previous Cask Editions, this Edition will be hand-crafted to our exacting standards.

This year, we have sourced three cask types that we have not used in our Descendants programme previously; Madeira, Cognac and Amontillado alongside more traditional casks Bourbon and Oloroso. Spirit will mature in each cask for a minimum of eight years however this can be left longer at the cask owners discretion.



As a Descendant, you will be sent a complimentary bottle of a new Dingle Whiskey each year, to enjoy while waiting for your own whiskey to mature. In addition, you may request an annual sample of your cask to observe its evolution over time. We also extend an invitation to you, as a Descendant, to visit and explore our distillery and warehouse as often as you like.

After eight years of maturation you will have a choice. You may opt to continue maturing your whiskey in its cask at our warehouse to achieve and older, more complex whiskey. Alternatively, you can choose to have it bottled on-site using our bottle and a label specific to the 2024 Cask Edition. This limited edition label will be adorned with the Descendant's own name, group or business name for a truly unique whiskey.

Ultimately, the final stage of your cask journey will be to sip, savour, and enjoy your whiskey. Whether you share it with friends and family, choose to sell the bottles onwards or use it as a corporate gift, each bottle will represent a piece of your history and be a part of the history of the distillery.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

OWNERSHIP

- On receipt of your completed and signed Terms and Conditions form and on receipt of full payment, the title for the cask will transfer to the named purchaser. If you are availing of the payment plan, you will have the rights of a Descendant from initial payment however full title and ownership will only transfer upon final payment.
- The cask owner commits to the full programme length of eight years and is not entitled to bottle the cask until this stage.
- No subsequent transfer, trading of title or sale of the cask to a third party is permitted by the purchaser.
- The purchaser may not sell the cask to a third party, nor will the distillery purchase back the cask.
- The purchaser must have the cask bottled and labelled by the distillery, payable by the purchaser. Off site bottling is not permitted.
- The cask can be owned by an individual or a company and there may be multiple names associated with the cask, however, only one name is permitted on the cask title and the onus is on that person to communicate with others involved.
- Should you wish to buy a cask as part of a group, this is possible. One person must be appointed “owner”. This person will also be the only individual who can avail of the complimentary Single Malt bottle, the annual sample, 15% discount at our Distillery and on-line shops and a complimentary tour (plus one) of the Distillery. Shipping is payable by the purchaser for annual bottle of whiskey (except for addresses in ROI)
- The purchaser must advise Dingle Distillery of any changes to their contact details given at the time of purchase.
- Should each group member pay €250, they then can avail of all aspects of the programme including the below:
 - The opportunity to sample your cask on request at a maximum of once per annum. Any shipping costs will be paid by the cask owner.
 - A bottle of Dingle Single Malt will be sent to you annually for the first 8 years of the Cask Programme.
 - You will receive plus one access to a tour of Dingle Distillery. This benefit will exist for as long as your cask matures in our warehouse.
 - Private access to Dingle Distillery warehouse to see and sample from your cask (once per annum).
 - 15% discount in Distillery shop & on-line store.

MATURATION & SAMPLING

- Fifteen years of storage costs are included in the price. Following this period, charges will apply for further maturation.
- Casks in the warehouse are insured by Dingle Distillery against fire and theft.
- The casks will be stored in the Dingle Distillery warehouse and we reserve the right to move all casks subject to the needs of the business.
- Access to the warehouse is available by prior appointment only. Please contact: descendants@dingledistillery.ie to reserve time.
- You may request samples of your cask at any stage either during a scheduled warehouse visit or via post (shipping charges will apply).

BOTTLING & LABELLING

- When you are thinking about bottling your cask, firstly, make sure you request a sample and then give us a minimum of 3 months' notice of your intention to bottle. This is required for both partial and full bottling.
- The purchaser can partially bottle a minimum of 78 bottles and a maximum of 2 bottlings in total over the lifetime of the cask.
- You will then need to pay the associated VAT, excise duty and bottling fee in advance of bottling.
- All "Descendants" whiskey will be bottled in the designated Dingle Distillery bottle with "Descendants" label and your desired name, cask type, cask strength and cask number on it. No other label is permitted.
- Partial and later full bottlings will have the same label on all bottles while the year of the whiskey will be printed on each label with date of bottling.
- Each cask will be bottled with one label and at one strength regardless of the number of bottlings. You can choose to bottle your whiskey at 46.5% or at Cask Strength; your samples and conversations with the Master Distiller should help you decide.
- Each cask is subject to the "Angels' Share". This is where we see evaporation in the cask of approximately 2.5% per annum while we also expect to see losses in bottling at around 1-2%. The above is estimated and may change from cask to cask.
- Due to Health & Safety Regulations, witnessing of the emptying of the cask and bottling is not permitted.
- The purchaser must arrange for the bottles to be collected within 7 days of bottling.
- The purchaser is responsible for the arrangement, collection and transport of the bottles and for the costs associated with this.
- The purchaser can take possession of their empty cask after final bottling. However, removal off site of full or partially full cask is not permitted.

TAXES, EXCISE DUTY & BOTTLING CHARGES

- The purchaser is solely responsible for any VAT and Excise Duty payable on removal of the whiskey from bond. VAT and duty are payable by the purchaser at the time of bottling. The amount will depend on the number of bottles produced from the cask. As an indication (based on rates in January 2024):
 - Current excise duty in Ireland for Single Malt 46.5% strength is €13.85 per bottle and for a Cask Strength of 60% is €17.88 per bottle. This figure will vary depending on the actual cask strength of your bottles.
 - Bottling cost is subject to the costs at the time of bottling, to give an indication the price is currently €5 plus VAT.
 - Current VAT is 23%, however this is subject to change, and is payable on the cask purchase price, duty and bottling costs.

COMMUNICATION

- Dingle Distillery will communicate with the individual noted on the Purchase Form regarding the details of the cask, maturation, bottling and anything else pertinent to the cask.
- Dingle Distillery will communicate with all members of the cask in relation to our regular updates and invitation to the Descendants Gathering.
